Steve Weidner's 1966 coupe is this month's spotlight car. Steve's car is painted chrome yellow from a 1999 Mustang and has a 289 V8, C4 automatic transmission, power steering and power disc brakes. The car currently has standard black interior but will soon be upgraded to pony sport seats. Steve bought his Mustang 6 or 7 years ago as a mostly complete car but needing a lot of work. Over the next 3 or 4 years with help from his son Kyle they restored the car to its current condition. When he bought the car he wanted to build a car like he would have built in high school, if he had the chance back then. He put chrome Cragar SS wheels on it and dressed the engine compartment up with as much chrome as he could find. His mechanic often reminds him after working on the car that "chrome won't get you home" but Steve quickly reminds him that chrome will win you a lot of trophies at the car shows.
