Frank welcomed and introduced new members in attendance.

Tiann Blackburn read the Treasurer's Report--Ending balance 1351.88.

### **Old Business:**

-Car Show—volunteers for the car show met following the regular meeting. Progress for this event is moving along. A letter has been drawn up and we will soon begin soliciting local businesses for donations and support for our event.

### **New Business:**

- **Club Banner**—Stacey Stater made a banner for The Club to be posted at the Golden Corral in our meeting space area. The cost for the banner was \$47.50, which Frank said for Tieann to reimburse Stacey.

**-Activities Calendar**—Claud Blackburn passed calendars out for the 2011 season. We discussed any changes or additions that need to be made to the calendar. Jim Rudicel made mention that the normal date (November 12<sup>th</sup>) for the Thanksgiving Pitch-In is not available this year. The only dates that are available are the 5<sup>th</sup> and the 26<sup>th</sup>. We made the decision to change the event to the 5<sup>th</sup>. # Recipe Corner

## Grasshopper Pie Recipe



- Prep: 15 min. + chilling

### Ingredients

- 1-1/2 cups cold milk
- 1 package (3.9 ounces) instant chocolate pudding mix
- 2-3/4 cups whipped topping, *divided*
- 1 package (4.67 ounces) mint Andes candies, chopped, *divided*
- 1 chocolate crumb crust (9 inches)
- 1/4 teaspoon mint extract
- 2 drops green food coloring, optional

### Directions

- In a small bowl, whisk milk and pudding mix for 2 minutes. Let stand for 2 minutes or until soft-set. Fold in 3/4 cup whipped topping. Fold in 3/4 cup candies. Spoon into crust.
- In another bowl, combine extract and remaining whipped topping; add food coloring if desired. Spread over pudding layer; sprinkle with remaining candies. Cover and refrigerate for 4 hours or until set. **Yield:** 8 servings.
