Recipe Corner

Honey Bunn Cake

1 pkg. Butter recipe yellow cake mix
2 sticks margarine, softened
4 eggs
8 oz. Sour cream
½ cup brown sugar, packed
1/3 cup pecans, chopped
2 tsp. Cinnamon
1 cup powdered sugar—doubled the icing and added 1 to 2 tablespoons honey
1 T. milk
1 tsp. Vanilla

Remove ½ cup dry cake mix. Beat remaining mix, eggs, butter and sour cream. Pour half of batter in a greased 9 x 13" pan. Stir together reserved cake mix, brown sugar, pecans and cinnamon. Sprinkle over batter in pan. Carefully spread remaining batter evenly over pecan mixture. Bake 30 to 33 minutes at 350 degrees. Stir powdered sugar, milk and vanilla to a drizzle consistency. Poke top of warm cake several times with fork. Spread drizzle over top of cake. Cool completely. Store covered.
